**CRITERIA FOR SUBMITTING A PROPOSED
STATE TOURNAMENT OF CHAMPIONS SITE**

Lake acreage requirement:	5,000+ Acres
Boat Docking Requirement:	Space for 30 Boats
Water Area:	Space for 100 to 120 Boats
Toilet Facilities:	Sufficient for Tournament

Pre-Tournament meeting sites (Sponsoring club responsibility):

1. Provide adequate meeting space for all participants of the State Tournament (250-300).
2. Provide adequate meeting space for all participants of the Alternate's Tournament (50).

Trophy Sponsor Requirement:

1. In writing when proposal is submitted.
2. Trophy List:

a. Alternates	1 st thru 4 th place	=	4
	Alternates Big Bass	=	1
b. State Finishers	1 st thru 20 th place	=	20
	TOC Big Bass	=	1
c. Top three teams	(seven for each team)	=	<u>21</u>

Banquet Sponsor Requirements (Optional)

1. In writing when proposal is submitted.
2. Sponsor will provide adequate banquet space for all participants of the State Tournament. (250-300)
3. Sponsor will provide a meal for all participants and may charge extra for spouses. (250+)

Lodging Requirements:

1. Sponsoring club to provide a list of all accommodations available in area of State Tournament. This is to be available as soon as the sight has been chosen.

Sponsoring Clubs Requirements:

1. Provide at least 3 members for the tournament committee.
2. Obtain all necessary permits for tournament 60 days prior to tournament.
3. Obtain all prizes for banquet 60 days prior to tournament.
4. Provide an additional 5 members to work the alternates and State Tournament.
5. Obtain the tournament trailer, 2 weeks prior to State and Alternates Tournaments.
6. Take inventory of supplies in tournament trailer and request any additional supplies from Tournament Director two weeks prior to the State and Alternates Tournaments.
7. Pick up, set up, clean and take down tournament trailer.
8. Transport tournament trailer to and from tournament site.
9. Remove all fish weighed in dead.
